  - 3.3. <u>As appropriate, Spartan will implement and maintain security measures to prevent unauthorized disclosure of EMS information (including audits and reviews) and documentation.</u>
  - 3.4. All employees will refer internal and external inquiries to EHS.
  - 3.5. <u>All external requests for information related to the environmental aspects or EMS will be referred to top management.</u>
  - 3.6. A top management representative shall consider a process for communicating its significant aspects to external parties and record this decision.
